SPEECH-LANGUAGE PATHOLOGIST

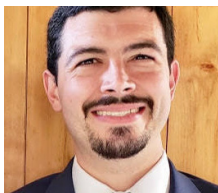

BUILDING SUBSTITUTE

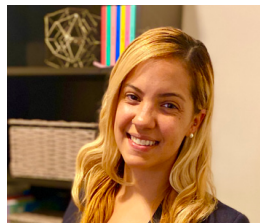

SCHOOL PSYCHOLOGIST

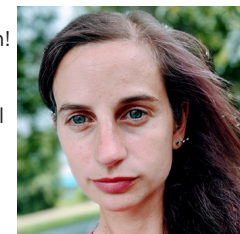

PHYSICAL THERAPIST

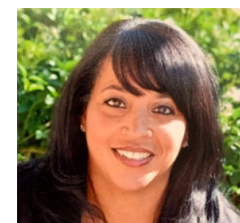
